







The Canadian Dental Care Plan Update

The Canadian Dental Care Plan (CDCP) helps ease financial barriers to accessing oral health care for eligible seniors, children and Canadians across generations.

Since the start of the program we have seen great progress!

- More than 200,000 seniors have accessed care through the CDCP
- More than 11,100 dental care professionals have now signed up to provide care under the CDCP.
- And 2,000,000 Canadians have been approved to receive dental care under the CDCP.


We are expanding the Canadian Dental Care Plan gradually. In June, the program will provide eligibility to children under 18 and people with disabilities starting June 27th!

Seniors aged 65 and above are now eligible to apply for the CDCP online without needing an invitation letter.

Under the Canadian Dental Care Plan we are providing fair, affordable, and accessible dental care across generations and across the nation!
